



WELCOME – LET'S ALL PLAY SAFELY

Please sign in the visitor's book and read the following safety information.

- Children must be accompanied by an adult **at all times**.
- Please wear the visitor's badge that has been provided.



Keep a sharp lookout for moving vehicles arriving and departing the site, or manoeuvring to unload or load, particularly near the loco preparation areas.

Fences and barrier tape are there for safety reasons, so please don't stray beyond them or enter areas marked 'members only' or 'loco preparation area', unless you have been authorised to do so.



- Only cross the tracks at the level crossing
- Obey the crossing signals and notices provided.
- Stop, look and listen at the crossing and **never** cross in front of an approaching train.

Engines are fun but can also be dangerous.

- Please stay out of the Loco Preparation Areas.
- Never get very close to or touch steam engines as they are scalding hot and can emit steam or smoke unexpectedly, even when they are stationary.



If you take a ride on a train.



- Please listen to the safety briefing given by the person in charge of the train.
- Step over the carriage when boarding and don't stand on the footrest as this will tip the carriage.
- Ensure any long or trailing clothing are securely tucked in (e.g. scarves, shawls, etc.)
- Stay seated when riding and don't lean out as this may tip the carriage.
- Keep your feet on the footrests so they don't get trapped underneath.
- Don't reach out. Keep your hands in and avoid trapping them between vehicles.
- Steam engines may emit ash and soot, so safety specs are available if you want them.
